



HOW TO BE FPCR IN THE PHILIPPINE COLLEGE OF RADIOLOGY (PCR): v. 2023

1) First, You must first be an official DPBR (must have passed the PBR 1-3 and have taken the oath during the induction ceremony of the PCR annual convention held every February).

2) **OPTIONS ON HOW TO APPLY FOR FPCR STATUS:**

a. Submit an ERB/EHRO approved completed Research Paper, with you as the primary author, on or before the announced deadline (see PCR Schedule of deadlines for the year) ¹

b. Be a member of any of the PCR standing committee or of any of the Annual Convention committee of the PCR for five (5) years. Best to keep the certificates of appreciation as a committee member. Your name will be cross referenced in our Annual Convention flyer and program. ¹

c. Submit a completed research paper related to the practice of Radiology that has been published in a Peer Reviewed Journal (local or overseas), with you as a main author (the paper cannot be used by another applicant for FPCR application nor have been used for PBR requirements). ¹

d. Deliver five (5) lectures in a PCR/PMA related activity eg. Scientific meetings of any of the PCR component society or RTC, interdepartmental/hospital conferences, webinar, etc. and secure a copy of the certificate of appreciation that can be verified by the PCR secretariat. ¹

e. If you are already a DPBR for at least 10 years during the time of application, AND IS ALSO a FELLOW

of any of the PCR Subspecialty societies (eg FCTMRISP, FUSP, FPROS, FPSVIR), submit the application form for FPCR status and submit the requirements and the form on or before the deadline. Deadline TBA (usually during the last quarter of the year) ².
