

Dear Doctors:

Good news! If you are already a DPBR for at least 10 years during the time of application (INDUCTED as a DPBR on or before 2012) BUT IS NOT A FELLOW of any of the PCR Subspecialty societies, here is your opportunity to be a qualified applicant for FELLOW Status (FPCR), through a series of webinars to be held by the PCR.

To qualify for FPCR status application, one of the options is to deliver FIVE (#5) lectures to PCR related meetings (or to any of its component societies-chapters, subspecialty, or new allied subspecialty societies), PMA conferences, interdepartmental/interhospital conferences or international Radiology conferences. To facilitate this, the PCR will hold a series of webinars entitled "PCR Connect: Leveling Up For The PQF". This is to assist our members who find it very difficult to make research papers or join the PCR committees for 5 years, due to their current non-academic work set up or inability to render PCR service away from work, respectively.

All you have to do is to get in touch with the PCR Secretariat at: (02) 83738462 or +639178749060. Inform them that you are opting for this pathway and will render five (lectures) each lasting for 15 mins (or if you have already presented lectures in the past and have certificates at hand, then render only the number of lectures to complete the required five (5) lectures). Provide the PCR Secretariat the topics of the lectures. Submit a recording of your lectures on separate files. We advise you to record using PowerPoint. The topics must be on Radiology and related topics (e.g., Patient/Workplace safety in Radiology, finances, AI etc.). These may also be lectures that can be used as reviewers for our PBR applicants for the upcoming Radiology Board examinations PBR).

The materials will be reviewed by the PCR Board of Directors, RTC or other appointed PCR members. Once

accepted, the PCR Secretariat will inform you of the scheduled playdates of your lectures.

Please be present during the QandA session of your scheduled lectures. This offer is valid only this year, and the PCR webinar series might run only until the end of October (before the deadline for the submission of FPCR Application forms). The PCR Connect webinar series' frequency of broadcast online will depend on the number of interested parties. So, grab this rare opportunity and be inducted as FPCR next year 2024 and level up your PQF.
