Whereas the AMENDED 2012 BY-LAWS OF THE PHILIPPINE COLLEGE OF RADIOLOGY (PCR) was SEC approved last 2021

Whereas the ARTICLE 4 on MEMBERSHIP states that “4.1 Membership to the College is a privilege, not a right, and is contingent upon the candidate’s compliance with the eligibility requirements and upon the final approval of the Board of Directors.”

Whereas Article 4.2.2 Fellows states that “Persons are eligible to become Fellows, if they: 4.2.2.1 Have at least one (1) year tenure as Diplomate; and 4.2.2.2 Have fulfilled the requirements prescribed by the Philippine College of Radiology”

Whereas, induction as Fellow of the PCR is held every February during the Annual Convention

Whereas an online meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Philippine College of Radiology (PCR) on January 28, 2023, using the Zoom platform, a quorum was present.

Now, therefore, be it resolved that, pursuant to the PCR Bylaws, the Board of Trustees of the PCR hereby announce that the total amount to be paid by those applying for Fellow status under the PCR will be 2,500.00 PHP to include application, processing and miscellaneous fees. The amount collected will be placed in the account of the PCR Research Foundation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT pursuant to the PCR Bylaws, the Board of Trustees of the PCR hereby announce that members who have a Diplomate status (DPBR) prior to 2013, or DPBR for at least 10 years, who are already FUSP or FCTMRISP may now apply for Fellowship status, provided that they are in good standing, a current staff member or intending to be a staff member of a PCR accredited institution, endorsed by a Fellow of the PCR in good standing, must have a significant contribution to the PCR, their chapter or institution.
