

**CONFORME ON POLICIES FOR NON-FILIPINO FOREIGN MEDICAL GRADUATES TAKING THE PHILIPPINE BOARD OF RADIOLOGY EXAMINATIONS**

Pursuant to **PBR Resolution No. 2010-01** (approved by the PCR Board of Directors on February 06, 2011) which states:

“Resolved that a non-Filipino foreign medical graduate **DOES NOT** have the constitutional qualifications to be considered “Diplomate” and hence, after successfully passing all the steps of the PBR examination, should be awarded a certificate **WITHOUT** the title of Diplomate.”

Therefore, in compliance with this PBR resolution, successfully passing all the steps of the PBR examinations (PBREI , PBRE II, PBRE III) :

- 1. validates my completion of the prescribed four year residency training program in Diagnostic Radiology in a PCR accredited training hospital
- 2. qualifies me to be issued a CERTIFICATE WITH RESTRICTIVE CLAUSE, as follows:
  - 2.a. DOES NOT confer on me the status of Diplomate of the Philippine Board of Radiology
  - 2.b. DOES NOT allow me to practice the specialty of Diagnostic Radiology in the Philippines (in accordance with Article XII Section 14 of the 1987 Constitution of the Republic of the Philippines; Professional Regulation Commission Resolution no. 98-547, Series of 1998)
  - 2.c. WILL NOT qualify me to be a member of the Philippine College of Radiology

I fully understand and agree to the above stated policies and the conditions that are attached to my successful completion of the PBR examinations.
